Minister for Foreign Affairs Honourable Dr. Arzu Rana Deuba paid a courtesy call on His Excellency Shri Narendra Modi, Prime Minister of India, in New Delhi today. During the call on, views were exchanged on further consolidating Nepal-India relations and expanding mutually beneficial cooperation between the two countries. While conveying warm greetings and best wishes from the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister K P Sharma Oli, she handed over his invitation to His Excellency the Prime Minister of India for a State Visit to Nepal.

Earlier today, Honourable Dr. Rana Deuba had a bilateral meeting with His Excellency Dr. S. Jaishankar, Minister of External Affairs of India. Both Ministers reviewed overall aspects of Nepal-India relations including matters relating to trade and transit, energy, connectivity, investment, air routes, flood and inundation, Pancheshwor Multipurpose Project, sports, border infrastructure, among others. The two sides also agreed to continue engagements at various levels including through regular bilateral mechanisms.

His Excellency Dr. Jaishankar hosted a luncheon in honour of the Honourable Foreign Minister of Nepal.
